


CT's Efficiency Programs

SBEA Features & Benefits

- Provides incentives to customers who agree to:
 - Energy-efficient lighting and/or controls
 - Refrigeration controls
 - HVAC equipment replacements
 - Compressed air systems
 - VFD
 - Many others
- Offers 0%, on-bill financing for qualifying customers, up to \$150K, 4 year term



Integrating Financing

- Customers want to implement efficiency projects to help them control their energy costs
- Incentives and financing are only a means to achieve that, not the objective itself



EE Financing Options

- A variety of financing products are available to meet the needs of individual customers
 - C&I Energy Efficiency Loans: Low-interest loans for commercial and industrial customers
 - Small Business Loans: Interest-free loans for implement eligible energy-savings measures.
 - CPACE: Property tax based, long-term financing
 - PURA & CHA Loans: Targeted financing opportunities for certain conservation and load management measures



Understanding Customers-Strategic Groupings




